## **BULLYING PREVENTION BEST PRACTICES**

Following definitions of bullying and cyber bullying, participants will learn specific techniques and strategies that will help them develop a better understanding of off-line and on-line bullying behavior. Trainers will review research based best practices and their practical guidelines for implementing a system-wide approach to preventing peer abuse. Participants will also discuss myths about bullying, ways to acknowledge positive behavior, and to empower bystanders to help targets of bullying. The presentation will give participants practical ways to create and enhance welcoming, peaceful environments within their organization where positive and respectful behaviors are practiced in order for all youth to achieve personal and interpersonal success.



## **GAME ON: BULLYING USING TECHNOLOGY 101**

Bullying using technology gets a lot of popular press, and unfortunately not everything we read is accurate. Utilizing a common definition of bullying and scenarios of real life situations, participants will identify what is, and what is not, bullying in the social media/digital world.
